

# SIENA



Siena is an hour and a half from Le Sodole. You can choose whether to take the Fi-Pi-Li into Florence to join with the autostrada for Siena or go part way cross country on a more direct route - the time will be similar.



Siena is a UNESCO World Heritage Site and famous for its Palio (horse race) held twice each year. The Piazza Del Campo is the centre piece (and hosts the Palio) and views from the top of the Torre del Mangia are worth the 400 steps. You can alternatively watch life from a lower level and just have a coffee! Anyway head for Piazza Del Campo and take it from there.



Market Day is Wednesday but get there early (in the morning rather than afternoon), it's said to be the largest market in Tuscany.

Siena is also a great Sunday destination and you should take the extra trouble of eating in Locando Amordivini in Asciano after your morning in Siena - that's an experience in itself!
