

VOLTERRA



Just as Lucca is probably the most popular day out heading north, Volterra is a great destination if you choose to drive south. You'll get there in under an hour and the scenery is great. There's also lots of choice on how to fill your day because as well as being a great destination in its own right Volterra can be grouped with lots of other options for a day touring Tuscany.



Couple Volterra with a lunch plan either on the way there or back and you can plan to eat at Officine Bocelli in Lajatico or at Osteria Ristorante San Vivaldo. If you want to have a two centre day trip then add San Gimignano (45 minutes) or Bolgheri (1 hour). The shirt manufacturer Poggianti is also on your route so stop in for some fine Italian shirts.

Directions to Volterra - head south toward Forcoli and then follow signs for Lajatico and Volterra - look out for Poggianti and Officine Bocelli on the way. Come back the same way or swing east to San Gimignano or west to Bolgheri.
